

7 Miracles that happened at Calvary are a picture of the progress we make in the Christian walk, much like the 23rd psalm.

- 1). Matt. 27:45 – the miracle of darkness – picture of sin
Darkness has no existence by itself; it is simply defined as the absence of light.
Darkness is the natural environment for evil to exist
- 2). Matt. 27:51 – the rent veil – picture of restoration
Just like when Saul ripped the robe of Samuel (1 Sam. 15: 29) the kingdom has been given to one who is better. That is Jesus.
- 3). Matt. 27:51 – The earthquake and the rocks split – picture of renewing the mind
There was an earthquake at Mt. Sinai when the 1st covenant was given. That covenant was the Law. The law is the place where strongholds exist in peoples minds. The earthquake at Calvary was a symbol of that covenant ending.
- 4). Matt. 27:52 – the graves were opened – picture of righteousness
Exhuming a body requires much effort because of it is sensitive.
Righteousness is a sensitive issue. He made you righteous.
- 5). Matt. 27:52 – they came out to the graves – picture of maturity
A mature person will follow the Lord wherever He may lead.
(Philippians 2:12-14)
- 6). John 20:5-7 – the folded grave cloths – picture of the 9 fold fruit of the spirit
The cloth was folded because it represented the fact that He is coming back.
Maturity leads us into bearing fruit.
- 7). John 20:11-19 – the resurrected & glorified body of Jesus – picture of glory
(Rom. 6:4) – it was the glory of God that raised Jesus from the dead
You will have a glorified body too, if you know the Lord.
